- 5. Improved workplace access for unions on health and safety matters.

SECURE JOBS

- Ended sham contracting, preventing employers insisting on employees having ABNs
- 2. Introduced more rights for casuals, and made it easier for them to convert to permanent roles.

- 5. Opened 87 Medicare Urgent Care Clinics to provide bulk-billed healthcare to under-served communities, particularly in the regions.
